COURSE AIMS:

The aim of this course is to develop students' English language skills with a focus on sustainable gastronomy.

By the end of the course, students will have improved their vocabulary skills and designed an English-language fine dining concept that integrates environmental, social, and economic considerations.

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW:

This course enhances English communication skills through the context of sustainable fine dining. Students will engage with authentic materials such as menus, interviews, and case studies to build fluency and professional vocabulary. Interactive sessions will support the development of intercultural awareness and sector-specific language competence.

A guest speaker from Villa Kabala, a Michelin Green Star restaurant, will provide first-hand insights into sustainability practices in high-end gastronomy.

The course concludes with a final assignment submitted via Coospace.
