Minhaj University Lahore (MUL) promotes global academic exposure through semester-long exchange programs for inbound (foreign students coming to MUL) participants. Within the framework of bilateral agreements and international cooperation protocols, students wishing to come to Minhaj University Lahore (MUL) for academic study, research, training, observation, or cultural exchange are kindly requested to complete the International Student Application Form via Google Forms. Application Deadline: January 15, 2026

Spring Semester Begins: April, 2026

For Inbound International Students:

- Enrollment in a recognized home university.
- Minimum 2.0 CGPA (or equivalent).
- Letter of English proficiency from host university
- Valid passport & student visa (MUL provides admission letter).
- Character Certificate.
- Medical Fitness Certificate
- Letter of recommendation



Fee Structure (Inbound Students)

Total Estimated Cost (1 Semester): \$500–\$1,000 (excluding Traveling & personal expenses).

Visa & Legal Policies

- MUL provides admission letters but does not guarantee visa approval.
- Students must comply with Pakistani laws and MUL's code of conduct.
- No refunds after the semester begins.

Application Process

For Inbound Students:

1. Submit:
 - Application form.
 - Transcripts + passport copy.
 - Proof of English proficiency (e.g., IELTS or English proficiency letter, medical certificate, character certificate, recommendation letters, etc.)
2. MUL issues admission letter for student visa.

Post-Exchange Requirements

- Submit a detailed experience report.
- Attend a certificate award ceremony.
- Provide feedback via testimonials/surveys.

Terms & Conditions

1. **Duration: 1 Semester (4–6 months)** – Fall (Sep–Jan) or Spring (Feb–Jun) or Summer.
2. **Academic Credit Transfer:** MUL will provide an official transcript for credit transfer to the home university.
3. **Visa & Immigration:** Students must obtain a **student visa** before arrival. MUL will assist with visa documentation but does not guarantee visa approval.
4. **Refund Policy:** Before semester starts: 80% refund. After 1st week: No refund.
5. **Code of Conduct:** Must respect Pakistani laws & university regulations. No political/religious activism allowed.
6. **Health & Safety:** Medical insurance strongly recommended. On-campus medical facility available.
7. **Cultural Adaptation:** Orientation program upon arrival. Optional Urdu language classes.

Student will need to submit following documentation at the time of application:

1. Application form for Exchange Programs (Download link will be provided).
2. Transcript.
3. Nomination / Recommendation letter from the parent university.
4. Passport Size Photographs.
5. Certificate of Language Proficiency.
6. Copies of identification documents (Passport).
7. Visa documentation.
8. Medical fitness certificate.
9. Character Certificate.

5. International Students (Inbound Participants)

For Inbound International Students:

- Provide complete documentation (transcripts, passport, English proficiency, medical, and character certificates).
- Obtain a valid student visa before arrival in Pakistan.
- Abide by Pakistani laws and MUL's code of conduct.
- Attend orientation sessions and participate in cultural adaptation programs.
- Maintain good academic standing and class attendance.
- Submit feedback or testimonials after program completion.
